REWRITING HISTORY: THE SINKING OF HMS PATHFINDER IN 1914

Speaker is Dr. James White

Pathfinder was the first ship in history to be sunk by a torpedo. Nearly 300 seamen lost their lives, including my grandfather who served in the engine room. Naval historians lay blame on the crew in the engine room for not responding to an order to turn the vessel and avoid the oncoming missile. My research tells a different story.

Dr. James White taught Psychology and practiced as a psychotherapist in Guelph. Since retiring in 2008 he has written a number of books and articles, plays music and is an avid oarsman. He is both a member of the Huron County Historical Society and a Director.
